

# VIRTUAL ILC 2020

## COMPETITIVE EVENT SUMMARY

5.14.2020

### BIG PICTURE OVERVIEW

1. Online tests only:

### TESTING

- All testing will be conducted online. No proctors will be used. All tests are timed, open book / open notes. Dental Terminology and Medical Terminology will be 45 minutes timed, instead of 90 minutes. Medical Spelling will be 30 minutes instead of 60 minutes.
- National Geographic Learning Academic Testing Centers tests will be open June 18 – 25, 2020. Tests can be taken at any point during this week, at the competitor's discretion.
- Traditional competitive event tests and Healthcare Issues Exam will take place online between June 22 – 25, 2020. Each test will be open for 24 hours. Competitors must complete the online test within this 24 hour testing window. A full schedule of which 24 hours each event will test, is [posted online](#).

- For team testing events, (Forensic Science, HOSA Bowl, etc.) team members must log in to test within one hour of each other. Teams will need to coordinate together to find the best time they want to test within the allowed 24 hour window.

#### SKILL EVENTS

- Skill events will not have round two skill demonstrations.
- Two essay questions have been added to each skill event online test. These essay questions will be used as the tie-breakers for any ties that take place on the multiple choice test scores. No extra time will be added, so essays will need to be answered within the regular 60/90 minute testing window.
- Personal Care and Life Support Skills have been moved to a test, since no skill demonstrations will be offered at ILC. The test being developed will use the existing resources as listed in the event guidelines, and the time limit will be 90 minutes for 50 questions.

#### MEDICAL SPELLING

- Round 1 online test will take place first. The test time has been decreased from 60 minutes to 30 minutes. Then top scoring competitors will be asked to join a live Zoom meeting with the judges. Competitors will individually be given spelling terms and will go down a predetermined list of words. Competitors who get the furthest on the word lists will be declared 1-10<sup>th</sup> place winners.

#### EXTEMPORANEOUS HEALTH POSTER

- The secret topic will be posted Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Competitors will have a 12 hour window to draw their poster and upload a photo of it to Tallo/Wufoo for judging.

#### EXTEMPORANEOUS WRITING

- This event will be done in the online testing platform on Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Competitors will login to the platform, see the secret topic, and type their essay in response to the secret topic. Some of the formatting requirements will be removed since the typing will be done within the online platform.

#### JOB SEEKING SKILLS

##### INTERVIEWING SKILLS

- No application will be used. The cover letter and resume will be judged through Tallo as a round 1 and selected competitors will advance to round 2. For round 2, competitors will meet virtually with judges via Zoom and answer judge interview questions live at a set time. Final results will be determined by live interview score.

#### PREPARED SPEAKING

##### SPEAKING SKILLS

##### RESEARCHED PERSUASIVE WRITING & SPEAKING

- Competitors will upload a video recording of themselves giving their prepared speech.
- The requirement to upload the Researched Persuasive Writing & Speaking paper to Tallo remains the same, as does the requirement for the eligibility form for Speaking Skills.
- Final score for RPS will still be paper plus presentation.

#### BIOMEDICAL DEBATE-

- All teams will take the round 1 test. A select number of teams for round 2 will participate in a modified debate / presentation with judges via a live platform like Zoom. More information on the live debate presentation will be coming soon. Final results will be test score plus debate score.

## FORENSIC SCIENCE

- The round 1 test will be done on the online testing system. The online test will ALSO contain an autopsy / police report information for the case study. Teams will be asked to read the case study information and type their responses. Team members will take the test and answer case study questions individually, but scores will be averaged between both team members for final placement.

## CREATIVE PROBLEM SOLVING

### DYNAMIC DECISIONS

### PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

- The secret topic for round 2 will be posted May 4<sup>th</sup>. ALL teams will prepare a response to the secret topic and record a video of themselves giving the presentation for judges. These videos will be uploaded by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Parli Pro teams will record a video of themselves running the meeting with the motions given in the secret topic. Teams will also upload a copy of their meeting minutes to Tallo. **The Parliamentary Procedure test will be 50 questions, instead of 35 questions, and will still be 30 minutes in length. There will NOT be an opportunity this year for membership in NAP with a 70%+ test score.**
- All teams will also take the round 1 test scheduled sometime between June 22-25<sup>th</sup>
- Scores on the video presentations will be added to the test scores for final placement.

## HOSA BOWL

- More information will be posted as soon as it is available. All teams will still take the round 1 test. A select number of teams for round 2 will either participate in a live event with judges on Zoom or participate by answering questions online in a quizbowl game format.

## HEALTH CAREER PREPARATION

- The statement of interest will be uploaded to a posted Wufoo link for review by judges. Competitors will also be asked to record a video of themselves answering verbally the same questions in the statement of interest. The video will be uploaded at the same posted link. Final score will be statement of interest plus video presentation.

### EXPLORING MEDICAL INNOVATION

- Existing requirements uploaded to Tallo/Wufoo still hold true
- Teams and competitors will record a video of their presentation normally given to the judges
  - Secondary and Postsecondary / Collegiate division will upload these videos to Tallo by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Middle School division will upload these videos to Wufoo links we provide by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

- Teams DO NOT need to be physically with each other for the presentations. Options will be shared to allow teams to record their presentations virtually through platforms such as Zoom, Go To Meeting, etc. See the [Video Recorded Presentation Guidelines](#).
- Public Health will upload the round 2 video presentation only. Final score will be based only on the round 2 video presentation.
- Health Career Display, Medical Innovation, and Exploring Medical Innovations will also be allowed to upload 1-3 photos of their display boards / innovation in addition to currently required uploads.
